A Quick History Lesson

The Village of Schuylerville is known throughout the world for its rich and unique history. The Village of Schuylerville played a pertinent role in the infamous Surrender at Saratoga, the turning point of the American Revolution.

Getting to Fort Hardy Park

From the south: Take I87 North to Exit 16 (Ballard Road/Wilton) take a right onto the Ballard Road. Cross route 50 to Taylor Road. Turn right onto route 32 south. Take a left at Spring St. then your first right onto Beagle Lane and your first left onto Saratoga Street (Fort Hardy park).

From the North: Take I87 South to Exit 16 (Ballard Road/Wilton) take a left on to Ballard Road. Cross route 50 to Taylor Road. Turn right onto route 32 south. Take a left at Spring St. then your first right onto Beagle Lane and your first left onto Saratoga Street (Fort Hardy park).

Event Parking

Please look for signs! There will be parking attendants at Fort Hardy Park advising you of where to park.

Race Packet Pick Up

Packet pick up is located at the Start/Finish area and will begin at 7am the morning of the race. Runners will be issued a commemorative race shirt and their timing chip in their ace packet. We cannot issue race packets to anyone but the corresponding registered runner.

The Route

The 3.5 Mile route of the Revolutionary Run for Veterans will take you past many historical sites of the Revolutionary war. The Race starts at Fort Hardy Park which was built in August of 1755 by General Phinehas Lyman. Named after Sir Charles Hardy, Governor, of NY. The park was originally intended as a supply post for expeditions against Crown Point (The Johnson Expedition).

The Race continues along the Champlain Canal Tow-Path which is listed on the National Registry of Historic Places and is the link between many historic sites related to the siege of 1777 along the Hudson River. From the Tow-Path to Route 4 which takes you past The Schuyler House which was built in 27 days to replace the one there originally in 1777 and housed General Schuyler.

From the Schuyler House to the intersection of Routes 4 and 32 where you take Route 32 to Pratt Street in the Village of Victory Mills which was named most certainly due to the defeat of the British at the Battles of Saratoga, where Burgoyne surrendered his sword to Gates.

In the Village of Victory from Pratt Street to Herkimer Street and continuing on to Cemetery Road to Burgoyne Street passing the Saratoga Monument which is the highest point of the land. The monument stands 154.5 feet tall with stairs to the top. You can see historical plaques and a beautiful view from the top. It commemorates the surrender of British General Burgoyne to American General Gates on October 17, 1777.

From Burgoyne Street onto Clancy Street which is the home of the Saratoga County American Legion Post 278 of Schuylerville. From Clancy Street to University Street and then to Green Street to Ferry Street and returning to historical Fort Hardy Park and the finish line of the 3.5 mile Revolutionary run for Veterans!

Restrooms

Restrooms are located at Fort Hardy Park near the Start/Finish Line.

Medical Support

Medical support will be located at Fort Hardy Park. If you stop during the race and require medical attention, it will be up to the medical support team to determine if you are allowed to continue the race.

Weather

Temperatures vary during this time of year in New York. Please dress appropriately.

Volunteers

Volunteers will need to check in at the registration table and be issued a t-shirt to distinguish themselves from the runners. Temperature can be an issue this time of year, please dress appropriately. The issued t-shirts must be visible!


