

2014 RABIES CLINIC DATES

Location of Rabies Clinics:
4-H Training Center, Middleline Road, Ballston Spa

**March 18th April 15th, May 20st, June 17th,
July 8th, July 22nd, August 20th,
September 16th, October 14th, November 11th**

CATS ARE FROM 7:00 pm UNTIL 8:00 pm
(the cats must be in carriers)

DOGS ARE FROM 8:00 pm UNTIL 9:00 pm
(the dogs must be on a leash)

DOMESTIC FERRETS FROM 7:00 until 9:00pm
(must be in a cage or carrier)

The cost of the rabies clinics is free;
however, donations are accepted.

All vaccination certificates are written for one year.
If a previous signed certificate is produced, a three year certificate will be written.

General Rabies Information:

Animal rabies continues to be a serious public health problem in New York State. If you, a family member, or a pet comes in contact with an animal that could be a rabies suspect, you should contact Saratoga County Public Health at 584-7460. They will advise you what to do.

Rabies can be carried by any wild mammal (raccoon, skunk, fox, coyote, or bat). There are also precautionary measures taken if you are bitten by a domestic animal (dog, cat or ferret). If this happens, you should first obtain the owner's name, address and phone number. Then contact the Saratoga County Public Health Department at 584-7460.
