The Saratoga County Water Authority currently has an opening for a full time water plant instrumentation technician position within the Water Authority. Successful candidate will be responsible for preventative and emergency maintenance of plant instrumentation and computer components. Knowledge of instrument calibration, control wiring diagrams, power wiring diagrams, loop diagrams, programming communications and uninterruptible power supplies; knowledge of the theory, principles, hardware, testing equipment and procedures common to the repair and maintenance of electronic devices and electrical systems; knowledge of the symbols and standard practices used in the preparation of process and instrument flow diagrams and the ability to use technical libraries for instrument selection, application, maintenance, trouble shooting and problem analysis; Ability to work on PC based computer programs; including the ability to program using “Wonderware” based software. Working knowledge of the characters and major components of computer data collection systems for water production.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

Graduation from high school or possession of a New York State equivalency diploma and four (4) years of experience in routine and emergency maintenance on instrumentation and control systems in a water treatment plant, wastewater treatment plant, or industrial plant with flow, pressure and analytical field devices, pumps and valves, PLC’s computers and HMI’s and radio telemetry systems.
