ALBANY, RENNELAER AND SARATOGA COUNTIES TO ANNOUNCE 9-1-1 COMPUTER AIDED DISPATCH PARTNERSHIP

9-1-1 data to be shared by police, fire, and ambulance agencies across three counties

COLONIE— Albany and Saratoga County Sheriff's Craig Apple and Michael Zurlo and Rensselaer County Executive Kathy Jimino will host a 10 am press conference on Friday, April 15 at the Town of Colonie Public Safety Center, 312 Wolf Road, Latham to announce a public safety partnership that will allow the three Capital Region Counties to share a computer aided dispatch, 9-1-1 telephone and records management system.

Public safety agencies across the three Capital Region Counties to include Fire, Police and EMS will have a Tritech Software Systems computer aided dispatch (CAD) and mobile system which provides the modern technology needed to handle the increased demands. Information from any emergency call can easily be shared between them. With this, the three counties will be able to offer assistance to neighboring Public Safety Answering Points or Dispatch Centers by providing immediate backup in the event of large-scale emergencies in neighboring jurisdictions.
