

Equalization and Assessment Committee Minutes
February 6, 2012 – 3:00 p.m.

Present: Chairman Raymond; Supervisors Collyer, Hargrave, M. Johnson, Sausville, Jenkins, Lewza, Wood, Kinowski and Southworth; Ryan Moore, Mgmt. Analyst; Cindy Baker, Treasurer; Joanne Bosley, Real Property; Steve Dorsey, County Attorney.

Chairman Raymond called the meeting to order and welcomed all in attendance.

On a motion made by Mr. Hargrave, seconded by Mr. Jenkins the minutes of the January 11, 2012 meeting were approved unanimously.

Mrs. Baker distributed copies of three tender offers in the towns of Greenfield, Malta and Providence for a total of \$64,301.74 to all committee members for their review and approval.

On a motion made by Mr. Hargrave, seconded by Mrs. Johnson the tender offers in the towns of Greenfield, Malta and Providence for a total of \$64,301.74 were approved unanimously.

Mrs. Bosley distributed a copy of a tax roll correction for 2012 in the amount of \$38,610 from the Town of Stillwater for a parcel that was charged for 400 sewer units in error. The parcel should have only been charged for 235 sewer units.

On a motion made by Mr. Hargrave, seconded by Mr. Sausville the above 2012 tax roll correction in the Town of Stillwater for \$38,610 was approved unanimously.

Ms. Raymond said the auction lists have been distributed to all Supervisors for the March 16th auction. There have already been nine pulls from the list. The list is very long and there was some concern that the auction might go very late. Ms. Raymond said after speaking with the County Attorney it was determined that there would be sufficient reductions and removals that it could be handled in one night, rather than going to the expense and work of adding a second night. Ms. Raymond encouraged all Supervisors who feel that they have properties that should be pulled or should be paid to go back to their towns and encourage people to do that.

On a motion made by Mr. Jenkins, seconded by Mr. Collyer the meeting was adjourned.
