## PUBLIC HEALTH COMMITTEE MINUTES

## SEPTEMBER 3, 2008 – 3:30 P.M.

Chairman Lucia called the meeting to order and welcomed all in attendance.

## On a motion made by Mr. Wood, seconded by Mr. Wright the minutes of the July 2, 2008 meeting were approved unanimously.

Mr. Angstadt requested a resolution to amend the 2008 budget and contract as follows to reflect an increase of \$85,200 in additional State Aid funding.

## A motion was made by Mr. Wright, seconded by Mr. Sausville to approve a resolution amending the 2008 budget and contracts as stated above. Unanimous.

Mr. Angstadt requested a resolution to amend the <u>2007 contract only</u> with Transitional Services Association in the amount of \$19,500 for 100% OASAS funding. He said this is for 2007 agency expenses that are being paid with 2008 funds that have already been approved. The contract would reflect the following changes:
