Mr. Benosky recommended that all municipalities include Road Kill Handling in their training programs as well.

Mr. Hartman said his office has a video library on training that municipalities could borrow.

Mr. Benosky said another source for training videos would be Cornell Local Roads.

Mr. Hartman said when the Department of Labor comes to investigate a municipality they are going to ask for a copy of the training outline.

Mr. Rowland requested that Mr. Hartman collect a list of the videos available from Cornell Cooperative Extension, municipalities and the County Safety Office, to then be distributed to all Supervisors.

A motion was made be Mr. Wood, seconded by Mr. Costanzo to approve establishing a list of training videos that would be available to all municipalities. Unanimous.
