"Unapproved" Technology Committee Minutes November 16, 2011 – 4:00 p.m.

Mrs. Southworth asked if the job descriptions would be analyzed as well, in order to prioritize? Mr. Veitch said, yes, that could be done more easily now that all computers have been identified.
