Public Works Committee Minutes April 14, 2015 - 4:00 p.m.

Present: Chairman Grattidge; Supervisors Raymond, Allen, Sausville, Barrett, Lent and Wood; Ryan Moore, Deputy Administrator; Keith Manz, Tom Speziale, Public Works; Press.

Chairman Grattidge called the meeting to order and welcomed all in attendance.

On a motion made by Mr. Wood, seconded by Mr. Barrett the minutes of the March 10, 2015 meeting were approved unanimously.

Mr. Manz said the bids for the funding agreement for the CR 45 Bridge over the Kayaderosseras Creek Rehabilitation came in higher than the budgeted amount, so there is a net increase in every account. The amount that was allotted to this project last year was transferred into this years' budget; therefore, the net increase will be \$4,450 which is the county share of 5% of the overall increase.

Mr. Speziale said the total amount of the increase is \$88,900, with 80% federal, 15% state and 5% county.

A motion was made by Mr. Lent, seconded by Mr. Sausville to approve a revised supplemental funding agreement for the CR 45 bridge over the Kayaderosseras Creek in the amount of \$88,900 with the county's share of \$4,450. Unanimous.

Mr. Grattidge said the county received notice that there would be some additional CHIPS funding through the budget agreement that was passed by the State. He said the county's share will be approximately \$261,000.

Mr. Manz said the trip to the recycling facility in Albany was very interesting and worthwhile. He said the recycling program is going well.

Mr. Barrett said the Town of Clifton Park has too much material for the amount of containers that they have. He said on Saturdays they are filling all the existing containers and really need a fourth container. Mr. Barrett said he doesn't want to have bins that are not completely full to be picked up. He said they have had to use a machine to continually compress down what is in the single stream containers to make enough room.

On a motion made by Mr. Lent, seconded by Mr. Sausville the meeting was adjourned unanimously.
