

Public Safety Committee Minutes  
June 9, 2015 - 3:00 p.m.

Present: Chairman Barrett; Supervisors Wright, Ziegler, Johnson, Peck, and Allen; Spencer Hellwig, Administrator; Chad Cooke, Deputy Administrator; Deputy Chief Castle, Sheriff Zurlo, Sheriff's Office; Ed Tremblay, Emergency Services; Deborah Oligny, Animal Shelter.

Chairman Barrett called the meeting to order and welcomed all in attendance.

**On a motion made by Mr. Wright, seconded by Mr. Ziegler the minutes of the May 12, 2015 meeting were approved unanimously.**

Sheriff Zurlo requested approval for a Law Enforcement Agreement with the Village of Corinth for the period June 14, 2015 to May 31, 2016, at a cost of \$342,000.

**A motion was made by Mr. Johnson, seconded by Mr. Peck to approve a Law Enforcement Agreement with the Village of Corinth for the period June 14, 2015 through May 31, 2016 at a cost of \$342,000. Unanimous.**

Mr. Barrett said an Explorers Program has been started in Saratoga County for kids and young adults, giving them the opportunity to take part in the program in conjunction with the Saratoga County Sheriff's Department to learn what deputies do and how the organization works. The age group range is between the ages of 14 to 20, with twenty individuals already signed up.

Mr. Barrett said a Youth Court was just started in Clifton Park and has been a huge success, touching the lives of our 100 students at Shenendehowa through the program. Some of the fire departments have explorer posts where young adults are able to shadow firefighters and learn about the science of firefighting.

Mr. Hellwig said there was money budgeted this year as a part of the capital program to have roofs replaced on some of the shelters. The request for an agreement with Tecta America Weather Guard is for the shelter on Spruce Mountain at a cost of \$32,753.

**A motion was made by Mr. Peck, seconded by Mr. Allen to approve an agreement with Tecta America Weather Guard for the replacement of the shelter roof on Spruce Mountain at a cost of \$32,753. Unanimous.**

Mr. Tremblay distributed a copy of the monthly Fire Training Report to all committee members, and gave a brief update on the Edinburg Tower.

**On a motion made by Mr. Wright, seconded by Mr. Ziegler the meeting was adjourned unanimously.**
