SETTING 2016 SALARIES FOR CERTAIN TEMPORARY AND PART-TIME EMPLOYEES

WHEREAS, Resolution 226-13 approved the current collective bargaining agreement with General Unit #546 of the Civil Service Employers Association, Inc. which provides a cost of living increase of 2% in 2016 for the affected employees; and
