

side of the intersection. Discussion was held regarding the towns current review status and the letter the Town's engineer had sent to Stewart's Shops to address. This proposal does not pose any County issues, however comments regarding NYS DOH and DEC approvals for well and septic as well as NYS DOT approval for access along NYS Rte. 67 still need to be obtained by the applicant. There was also discussion held regarding the impacts of this new location with respect to the existing historic church. Ms. O'Neill recommended No Significant County Wide or Inter Community Impact with comments referenced above.

A motion to approve Planning Department recommendations for the referrals as presented was made by Mr. DalPos, the motion was seconded by Mr. Murray and unanimously approved.
