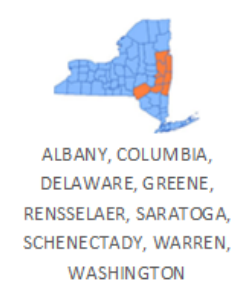

On any given day, approximately 2.7 million children in the United States has an incarcerated parent; that's one in 28 children. Because data on the actual number of children with incarcerated parents is hard to find or unreliable due to inconsistent reporting, this staggering estimate is likely an undercount. If asked, families are often hesitant to disclose parental incarceration due to the stigma attached to criminal justice involvement.
