Public Works Committee Minutes June 12, 2018 – 4:00 p.m.

Present: Chairman Preston Allen; Supervisors Paul Lent, Bill Peck, Jean Raymond and Jon Schopf; Chad Cooke, County Administrator; Steve Dorsey, County Attorney; Keith Manz, Tom Speziale, Public Works.

Chairman Allen called the meeting to order and welcomed all in attendance.

On a motion made by Mr. Schopf, seconded by Mr. Peck, the minutes of the April 10, 2018 meeting were approved unanimously.

A motion was made by Mr. Peck, seconded by Mr. Lent, to grant a no-cost easement over County-owned right-of-way in the Town of Greenfield to accommodate a drilled well. Unanimous.

Mr. Manz provided maps of the area in question. Mr. Manz said that the well was drilled 5ft into the County right of way. Mr. Manz said that the County has 60 feet of right of way in this area. Right of ways are typically 50ft and this well is 55ft from the centerline. Mr. Manz said that the property owner had requested to purchase a portion of the property however an easement is an easier process for the County. Mr. Peck suggested that language be included if the use of the well is abandoned that the easement would end. Mrs. Raymond suggested that language be included that would ensure the County is held harmless for any safety issues regarding the well.

On a motion made by Mr. Lent, seconded by Mrs. Raymond, the meeting was adjourned unanimously.
