A LOCAL LAW AMENDING THE 2020 COUNTY COMPENSATION SCHEDULE TO PROVIDE A COST-OF-LIVING INCREASE FOR CERTAIN COUNTY OFFICIALS

BE IT ENACTED by the Saratoga County Board of Supervisors as follows:

SECTION 1. The 2020 compensation for the following County officials shall be increased to the following levels, effective January 1, 2020:

RESOLUTION 41 - 2020

TERMINATING AGREEMENT WITH WARREN AND WASHINGTON COUNTIES FOR WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT BOARD APPPOINTMENTS, AND AUTHORIZING THE CHAIR TO EXECUTE A NEW AGREEMENT SUBJECT TO CERTAIN TERMS AND CONDITIONS

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution 169-2015, the Saratoga County Board of Supervisors authorized an agreement with the County of Warren and the County of Washington establishing Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act of 2014 ("WIOA") compliant guidelines for the selection, appointment, and maintenance of the membership of the Saratoga-Warren-Washington Workforce Development Board; and

WHEREAS, at this Board's organization meeting on January 2, 2020, Chairman Allen announced four appointments to the Saratoga-Warren-Washington Workforce Development Board ("SWWWDB") for a term of three (3) years; and

WHEREAS, included among the Chairman's appointees to the SWWWDB was Saratoga County Human Resources Director Margaret McNamara; and

WHEREAS, the SWWWDB's Executive Director, Douglas Leavens, and the Chairman of the SWWWDB's Board of Directors, Michael Perez, are refusing to recognize the Chairman's appointment of Margaret McNamara to the SWWWDB on the grounds that they believe her appointment does not fall within one of the categories of permissible appointees authorized by the SWWWDB membership agreement executed by Saratoga, Warren and Washington Counties; and

WHEREAS, WIOA regulations authorize the appointment of "appropriate individuals as determined by the chief elected official" as members of local workforce development boards; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to revise the SWWWDB membership agreement executed with Warren and Washington Counties to include among the categories of permissible appointees to the SSWWDB "appropriate individuals as determined by the chief elected official"; and

WHEREAS, the agreement executed with Warren and Washington Counties establishing WIOA compliant guidelines for the selection, appointment, and maintenance of the membership of the SWWWDB provides that the agreement shall stay in effect until terminated by a party to the agreement; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to exercise the County's right to terminate the agreement with Warren and Washington Counties in order to enter into a new agreement that includes among the WIOA-compliant guidelines for the selection, appointment, and maintenance of the membership of the SWWWDB the appointment of "appropriate individuals as determined by the chief elected official"; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the County of Saratoga hereby rescinds the agreement executed with the Counties of Warren and Washington in 2015 establishing WIOA- compliant guidelines for the selection, appointment, and

maintenance of the membership of the Saratoga-Warren-Washington Workforce Development Board; and, be it further

RESOLVED, that the Chair of the Board is hereby authorized to execute a new agreement with the County of Warren and the County of Washington establishing WIOA-compliant guidelines for the selection, appointment and maintenance of the membership of the Saratoga-Warren-Washington Workforce Development Board that must include, but not be limited to, authorization to appoint appropriate individuals as determined by the chief elected official; and, be it further

RESOLVED, that the form and content of such agreement shall be subject to the approval of the County Attorney.
