Meeting called to order at 3:01pm by Chairman Ropitzky.

- 1. <u>Minutes of February 2021 Meeting</u>: Motion to approve by Grasso, seconded by Koval, carried unanimously.
- 2. February 2021 Financial Reports:
  - a. <u>Receipts/Disbursements Report, Budget vs Actual Report and Vouchers:</u> (Attachment A, **B & C) Motion** to approve made by O'Connor, seconded by Koval, carried unanimously.
- Field Report: Grasso commented that Lewis did a great job presenting to the County Economic Development Committee & suggested that the District find one topic once a year to present to Board of Supervisors for exposure.
- 4. <u>Cooperating Agency Reports:</u>
  - a. NRCS: Teale submitted a report by email Working through Environmental Quality Incentives Program (EQIP) and Agricultural Management Assistance (AMA) program applications, will find out April 30<sup>th</sup> which applications(s) get funded. Conservation Stewardship Program (CSP) signup deadline is April 23. This is for producers who are currently good stewards and are willing to go above and beyond in their stewardship. There is a second round of AMA funding available for producers in urban areas. The funding is primarily for high tunnels. Deadline to apply is April 16. Current projects: 1 high tunnel in progress in Wilton, erosion control project in Schuylerville is designed and hopefully will go in this spring, forest stand improvement project in Galway should have the first phase completed by the end of the month.
  - b. FSA: No report.
  - c. RC&D: No report.
  - d. NYSSWCC: Monthly reported distributed to all by email.
  - e. NYACD: No report.
  - f. **CCE:** No report, Koval offered to contact CCE for information pertinent to the District.
- 5. Old Business:
  - a. <u>Water Quality Coordinating Committee:</u> No meeting this month, no report.
  - b. **<u>Grants:</u>** Lewis reported on the following:
    - i. Agricultural Environmental Management Next year starts a new round for AEM Projects, we will need to review Best Management Practices and decide which Practices to utilize for next round. Farms will need to be approve by Board and submitted to NYS for approval.
    - ii. CAFO Grants Final payment was issued to Koval, payment to NYS for unused funds being mailed back this week.
    - iii. Septic System No new activity, Lewis agreed to send out another mailing to eligible landowners later this year.
    - iv. Roadside Erosion No activity, staff will be hydroseeding in spring as part of the Grant.
    - v. Resiliency Training Working with Upper Hudson & Lake Champlain Coalition to set up the 9 trainers we are contracted to do. To date 7 trainings are planned without firm dates. The District will be holding a Rural Roads Management Training this summer.
  - c. <u>T&S 2021:</u>
    - i. Wages for T&S Workers 2021: A motion was made by O'Connor, seconded by Garlanda to pay new employees minimum wage of \$12.50 along with a \$.25 increase for returning workers, carried unanimously.

- **d.** <u>Envirothon 2021</u>: McCarthy reported that no teams have registered to date, deadline to register has been extended to March 31<sup>st</sup>. McCarthy will send out a reminder this week about registration.
- e. <u>Audit of 2020 Books</u>: McCarthy advised this was being left on the agenda so that when in person meetings return, the Board will remember to schedule the Audit.
- f. <u>No Till Rental Fees 2021</u>: A motion was made by Grasso, seconded by O'Connor to adjust the No Till Rental fee to a minimum fee of \$75 for 5 acres then \$15 for any additional acres effective 08/01/21, carried unanimously.

#### 6. New Business:

- a. <u>Office Carpet Replacement:</u> Lewis reported that Chad Cooke had come to the office to check out the vents, stated they looked good & feels the carpet needs to be replaced. Lewis has been notified that the new carpet has been ordered & will be replaced later this month.
- b. <u>Compensation Study Request:</u> A motion was made by O'Connor, seconded by Koval to contact County Human Resources Department to request a Compensation Study be completed for staff members, carried unanimously.

#### 7. Other Business:

- a. <u>New Board member:</u> A motion was made by O'Connor, seconded by Garlanda to submit Janet Bartow's name for approval to the Board of Supervisors, carried unanimously.
