#### **Background**

The above referenced single-lane bridge is an approximate 30-foot clear span filled aluminum arch bridge located on a former Town of Halfmoon roadway, Robert's Lane, that previously served a single private property (please see the attached map for location of the bridge within the Town of Halfmoon). The bridge was last improved through a replacement project in 2003 and has a current bridge rating of seven (7) indicating good condition. In 2020, the Town of Halfmoon, through a resolution of the Town Board, abandoned Robert's Lane and transferred ownership to the adjoining property owner, Synergy Park, LLC. Currently, the bridge is entirely encompassed by property owned by Synergy Park, LLC.

Synergy Park, LLC is in the process of improving the property and, following the Town's abandonment of the roadway, has approached the County regarding the disposition of the now isolated bridge. Synergy Park, LLC is currently utilizing the bridge to access their property and facility property improvements. To complicate matters, the Town's abandonment does not appear to include any access rights for the County to access its bridge for maintenance purposes.

#### **Options**

Based upon my review of County Highway Law and discussions with County Attorney Hartnett, there are two (2) options for addressing the disposition of the County-owned bridge; selling the bridge or abandoning the bridge. Selling the bridge requires a determination of the value of the bridge, holding a public hearing on the sale and the adoption of a local law conveying ownership. Abandoning the bridge requires a recommendation from the Commissioner of Public Works that the bridge is either unsafe or no longer serves any public interest. The abandonment provision also requires that barricades be erected at the ends of the bridge to prevent any use.

#### Recommendation

Abandonment of the bridge is problematic not only for the adjoining property owner that utilizes the bridge as the sole means of access to their property but also presents an issue related to County access to the bridge to facilitate abandonment provisions and the installation of barricades. As noted above, the County currently retains no rights of access following the Town's abandonment of Robert's Lane. The single dwelling on the western side of the bridge is unoccupied and scheduled for demolition.

As such, selling the bridge is the recommended action to convey ownership and terminate the County's interest. In terms of value, it is my opinion that given the current access rights issue, the Town's abandonment of Robert's Lane right-of-way, the fact the bridge only ever served to provide access to a single property, and the potential liability and maintenance issues that would remain through continued ownership, the bridge no longer serves any public interest. Monetarily, any scrap value in the aluminum structure of the bridge would be negated by costs associated with removing and transporting the material. As a result, it is my opinion that the bridge represents a negative value to the county when factoring the above in addition to ongoing maintenance and repair costs. As a result, I would recommend the sale of the bridge to the adjoining property owner for nominal value.

The first step in the process, should the committee choose to move forward, is setting a date and time for a public hearing on the proposed sale.
