

Public Safety Committee Minutes  
August 31, 2021– 3:30 p.m.

**On a motion made by Mr. Smith, seconded by Mr. Schopf, the minutes of the August 3, 2021 meeting were approved unanimously.**

**A motion was made by Mrs. Raymond, seconded by Mr. Connolly, to authorize the acceptance of a grant in the amount of \$138,956 from the New York State Department of Homeland Security for PSAP operations. Unanimous.**

Mr. Zurlo said this grant is for PSAP operations which are communications.

**A motion was made by Mr. Schopf, seconded by Mr. Connolly, to authorize acceptance of the 3<sup>rd</sup> Upstate Quality Improvement Grant. Unanimous.**

Mr. Blumenberg said this grant is over three years and is fully funded by ILS.

**A motion was made by Mr. Smith, seconded by Mrs. Raymond, to authorize the acceptance of additional aid from New York State STOP DWI Foundation Inc. in the amount of \$5,000. Unanimous.**

Mr. Carr said the application for \$5,000 for the Sheriff's Office was approved and this request is to accept the funds and amend the budget.

**A motion was made by Mrs. Raymond, seconded by Mr. Smith, to proclaim October as Domestic Violence Awareness Month in Saratoga County. Unanimous.**

Mrs. Heggen said she's asking for this item to shine a light on awareness regarding domestic violence.

**On a motion made by Mr. Schopf, seconded by Mr. Connolly, the meeting was adjourned unanimously.**
