SARATOGA COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING ON THE PROPOSED MODIFICATIONS OF SARATOGA COUNTY CONSOLIDATED AGRICULTURAL DISTRICT #2

Notice is hereby given that a public hearing will be held by the Saratoga County Board of Supervisors, in the Board of Supervisors' Meeting Room located at 40 McMaster Street in the Village of Ballston Spa, New York, on Wednesday, February 10, 2020 at 3:45 pm on proposed modifications of the boundaries of Saratoga County Consolidated Agricultural District #2.

Saratoga County Consolidated Agricultural District #2 presently encompasses portions of the towns of Ballston, Charlton, Clifton Park, Edinburg, Galway, Greenfield, Malta, Milton, Providence and the City of Saratoga Springs. There are approximately 4,357 parcels included within this District that contains approximately $56,937.32 \pm acres$ of land.

Two applications for the inclusion of predominately viable agricultural lands within Saratoga County Consolidated Agricultural District #2 have been filed with the Saratoga County Board of Supervisors pursuant to NYS Agriculture and Markets Law §303-b. The first application requests the inclusion of a parcel of land located in the Town of Galway on Hermance Road, consisting of 23.38± acres, identified as Tax Parcel #185.-2-20.27. The second application requests the inclusion of two parcels of land located in the Town of Corinth along NYS RT 9N consisting of a total of 32.22 ± acres, identified as Tax Parcels #73.-2-53.1 and #73.-2-53.2.

The hearing will consider the two applications received for inclusion within the boundaries of Saratoga County Consolidated Agricultural District #2, and the report of the Saratoga County Agriculture and Farmland Protection Board recommending the amendment of the boundaries of Consolidated Agricultural District #2 to include all three parcels referenced in the applications.

All parties appearing and desiring to be heard will be heard by the Saratoga County Board of Supervisors at this hearing. Due to public health and safety concerns related to COVID-19, there is limited capacity in the Boardrooms.
