SARATOGA COUNTY ANNOUNCES UPCOMING COVID-19 PRIMARY VACCINATION & BOOSTER CLINICS

Saratoga County Public Health Services department (SCPHS) is holding the following free COVID-19 vaccination clinics:

Pfizer Booster Clinics for Eligible Seniors age 65 or older:

Sunday October 17: 10AM-1PM at the Hadley Community Center (23 Maple St, Hadley)

Tuesday October 19: 9AM-10:30AM at the Saratoga Casino Hotel (342 Jefferson St, Saratoga Springs)

Friday October 22: 9AM- Noon and 1:30PM-3PM at Gavin Park (10 Lewis Rd, Saratoga Springs)

Primary Vaccine Clinic:

Tuesday October 19: Johnson & Johnson Vaccine Clinic 10:30AM-Noon at the Saratoga Casino Hotel (342 Jefferson St, Saratoga Springs)

Wednesday October 20: Johnson & Johnson Vaccine Clinic 9AM-Noon at the Saratoga County Public Safety Building (6012 County Farm Rd, Ballston Spa)

Registration is required for all clinics. The vaccines are free. No proof of insurance required. To register, please visit www.saratogacountny.gov/covid or call the county's COVID-19 Booster Clinic Call Center at (518) 693-1075. Saratoga County's COVID-19 Booster Clinic Call Center is available weekdays from 8AM to 4:30PM and weekends from 8AM to 2PM to help seniors make booster appointments within the county.

The Pfizer booster clinics are for those age 65 or older who received their second dose of the Pfizer vaccine at least six months prior to the date of the clinic they attend. Individuals who received Moderna or Johnson and Johnson vaccine are not eligible to attend these clinics.

The Johnson and Johnson COVID-19 vaccine is a single dose series authorized for use in individuals ages 18 and older.

Individuals under 65 years of age who received Pfizer vaccine and may be eligible for a booster can locate a vaccination by calling the Saratoga County Booster Clinic Call Center at (518) 693-1075 or visiting at www.vaccines.gov.

In an effort to help our most vulnerable population stay healthy, Saratoga County Public Health has launched a direct mail campaign to advise seniors when they become eligible for a COVID-19 booster and to provide information about how to register for a booster clinic or make an appointment with a pharmacy within the county. Seniors eligible for a

booster may register online through the Saratoga County website, at vaccines.gov, or by phone utilizing the county's call center at (518) 693-1075.

SCPHS provides free COVID-19 vaccine clinics and booster clinics at the county's Public Safety Building and through partnerships with private businesses across the county.

The county will once again work with EMS providers in Saratoga County to offer in-home vaccinations and boosters for the homebound. Homebound individuals or others with barriers to vaccination can also contact SCPHS at www.saratogacountyny.gov/covid.
