SARATOGA COUNTY ANNOUNCES UPCOMING COVID-19 BOOSTER CLINICS FOR SENIORS AGE 65+

Saratoga County Public Health Services department (SCPHS) is holding the following free COVID-19 Pfizer booster clinics:

- **Wednesday October 13:** 9:30AM-11:30AM and 1:30PM-3:30PM at Saratoga County Public Health (6012 County Farm Rd, Ballston Spa)
- **Friday October 15:** 9AM-Noon and 1:30PM-3PM at the Halfmoon Town Hall (2 Halfmoon Town Plaza, Halfmoon)

These clinics are for those age 65 or older who received their second dose of the Pfizer vaccine on or before April 13 or 15, respectively. Individuals who received Moderna or Johnson and Johnson vaccine are not eligible to attend these clinics. Visit www.saratogacountyny.gov/covid for a full list of upcoming clinics.

Registration is required for all clinics. The vaccines are free. No proof of insurance required. **To register, please visit www.saratogacountyny.gov/covid or call the county's COVID-19 Booster Clinic Call Center at (518) 693-1075.** Saratoga County's COVID-19 Booster Clinic Call Center is available weekdays from 8AM to 4:30PM and weekends from 8AM to 2PM to help seniors make booster appointments within the county.

Individuals under 65 years of age who received Pfizer vaccine and may be eligible for a booster can locate a vaccination at www.vaccines.gov or by calling 800-232-0233.

In an effort to help our most vulnerable population stay healthy, Saratoga County Public Health has launched a direct mail campaign to advise seniors when they become eligible for a COVID-19 booster and to provide information about how to register for a booster clinic or make an appointment with a pharmacy within the county. Seniors eligible for a booster may register online through the Saratoga County website, at vaccines.gov, or by phone utilizing the county's call center at (518) 693-1075.

SCPHS provides free COVID-19 vaccine clinics and booster clinics at the county's Public Safety Building and through partnerships with private businesses across the county.

The county will once again work with EMS providers in Saratoga County to offer in-home vaccinations and boosters for the homebound. Homebound individuals or others with barriers to vaccination can also contact SCPHS at www.saratogacountyny.gov/covid.
