AUTHORIZING THE CHAIRMAN TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE NEW YORK STATE DIVISION OF CRIMINAL JUSTICE SERVICES TO ACCEPT A 2021 CRIMES AGAINST REVENUE PROGRAM GRANT 2022

2021 WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution 243-2019, this Board authorized the acceptance of a 2020 Crimes Against Revenue Program Grant from the State Division of Criminal Justice Services ("DCJS") and the New York State Department of Taxation and Finance in the amount of \$118,900 to provide salary support to the District Attorney's Office for the investigation and prosecution of crimes related to the nonpayment of taxes and the commission of Medicaid, welfare, unemployment and Workers' Compensation fraud; and

WHEREAS, the State DCJS has made additional aid available in the amount of \$118,900 under the Crimes Against Revenue Program to provide continued salary support and travel reimbursement to the District Attorney's Office for the investigation and prosecution of crimes related to the nonpayment of taxes and the commission of Medicaid, welfare, unemployment and Workers' Compensation fraud for the grant period January 1, 2021 through December 31, 2021; and

WHEREAS, the State DCJS requests that the County approve and authorize the acceptance of this grant; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Chair of the Board of Supervisors is hereby authorized to execute all necessary documents with the New York State Division of Criminal Justice Services for the acceptance of a Crimes Against Revenue Program grant in the amount of \$118,900 for the grant period January 1, 2022 through December 31, 2022; with the form and content of such documents being subject to the approval of the County Attorney.
