SARATOGA COUNTY PUBLIC HEALTH HOLDS MODERNA AND PFIZER BOOSTER CLINICS FOR SENIORS

BALLSTON SPA, NY –Saratoga County is holding the following COVID-19 booster clinics for seniors age 65 and older:

Monday November 22:

- 9AM-Noon Pfizer booster at Saratoga County Public Health (6012 County Farm Rd, Ballston Spa)
To be eligible, you must have had your second dose of Pfizer or Moderna on or before 5/22/21 or Johnson & Johnson on or before 9/22/21.

Tuesday November 23:

- 9AM-Noon Moderna booster at Saratoga County Public Health (6012 County Farm Rd, Ballston Spa)
- 1:30PM-3:30PM Pfizer at Saratoga County Public Health (6012 County Farm Rd, Ballston Spa)
To be eligible, you must have had your second dose of Pfizer or Moderna on or before 5/23/21 or Johnson & Johnson on or before 9/23/21.

Important Information regarding Senior Clinics: The vaccines are free. No proof of insurance required. Registration preferred and strongly recommended. Limited, same day walk-in appointments will also be available.

Please visit www.SaratogaCountyNY.gov/COVID or call (518) 693-1075 to register for a clinic. Saratoga County's COVID-19 Booster Clinic Call Center is available weekdays from 8AM to 4:30PM and weekends from 8AM to 2PM to help seniors make booster appointments within the county.

While the currently scheduled booster clinics are available to our most vulnerable population, Saratoga County offers assistance to all residents seeking a vaccine or booster. Those under age 65 who are eligible for a booster may visit www.saratogacountyny.gov/covid for links and information to find a primary vaccination or booster at a local pharmacy.
