Clinics Scheduled for Tuesday, January 4, 2022 at Saratoga County Public Health

Saratoga County Public Health Services department (SCPHS) is holding the following free COVID-19 vaccination clinics:

Moderna Booster Clinic for Ages 18+ from 9AM to 12PM on Tuesday, January 4 at Saratoga County Public Health (6012 County Farm Rd, Ballston Spa)

Pfizer First Dose Vaccine Clinic for Ages 5 to 11 from 1:30PM to 3:30PM on Tuesday, January 4 at Saratoga County Public Health (6012 County Farm Rd, Ballston Spa)

To be eligible for a booster vaccine, you must have had your second dose of the Pfizer or Moderna vaccine at least six months prior to the booster clinic date you select or the Johnson and Johnson vaccine at least two months prior to the booster clinic date you select. The vaccines are free. No proof of insurance required.

Seniors may also call the county's COVID-19 Booster Clinic Call Center at (518) 693-1075 to register for a clinic. Saratoga County's COVID-19 Booster Clinic Call Center is available weekdays from 8AM to 4:30PM and weekends from 8AM to 2PM to help seniors make booster appointments within the county.

Important information regarding 5-11 year old Clinics: The child to be vaccinated should be accompanied by their parent or guardian. Only one parent/guardian may enter the vaccination clinic at a time. If the child is unaccompanied by their parent or guardian (for example, accompanied by a grandparent), a written consent form signed by the parent or guardian must be presented the time of the minor's vaccination. The consent form is available on the County's website and the clinic registration page.

SCPHS provides free COVID-19 vaccine clinics and booster clinics at the county's Public Safety Building and through partnerships with private businesses across the county.
