AUTHORIZING THE CHAIRMAN TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE NEW YORK STATE DEPARTMENT OF LABOR TO ACCEPT A 2020-2022 EMPLOYMENT RECOVERY NATIONAL DISLOCATED WORKER GRANT AND AUTHORIZING AN AMENDMENT TO THE 2021 COUNTY BUDGET IN RELATION THERETO

WHEREAS, the Employment Recovery National Dislocated Worker Grant (ER-NDWG) awarded by the United States Department of Labor to the New York State Department of Labor expanded eligible participants to include dislocated workers as defined by Section 3(15) of the Workforce Innovation and Opportunities Act (WIOA) including workers laid off as a result of a disaster such as the COVID-19 Pandemic; and

WHEREAS, a grant in the amount of \$43,701.26 is available from the New York State Department of Labor for the purpose of assisting with career services training services, supportive services and needs-related payments for eligible participants; and

38,811

WHEREAS, Saratoga County is the grant recipient for the Saratoga, Warren, Washington Workforce Development area and will retain \$22,838.28 of the award amount and pass the remaining \$20,862.98 to Warren County and Washington County; and

WHEREAS, the acceptance of this Employment Recovery National Dislocated Worker Grant requires our approval; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Chair of the Board and/or the Director of Employment and Training Administration is hereby authorized to execute all documents with the New York State Department of Labor necessary to accept a 2020-2022 Employment Recovery National Dislocated Worker Grant in the amount of \$43,701.26, of which \$22,838.28 will be retained by Saratoga County and the remaining grant award to be passed through to Washington County and Warren County; and it is further

10.	Remarks/Reasoning (Supporting documentation must be attached to this form): Saratoga County contracts with CCE for the management of the County MS4 Stormwater program. For 2022, the contract is in the amount of \$194,441.00 and is provided for in the 2022 Planning Department budget under account 1-80-000-8724. Prior to pandemic Saratoga County had a 3 year contract for with Cornell Cooperative Extension for these services (expired on 12-31-2020 with a yearly increase in payment. In 2021 due to the pandemic CCE requested a one year extension of the existing contract to continue the services. I have attached a marked up resolution from 2018 authorizing the 3 year contract with Cornell Cooperative Extension. The proposed contract term will be for 3 years with a yearly increase of 1.5%. The costs for these services will be as follows: \$194,441.58 for 2022, \$197,358.20 for 2023 and \$200,318.57 for 2024.

Proposal:

A continuation of the funding and action plan for the ISWM Program, including a 3-year contract interval, begun in 2018 that had been disrupted by the pandemic. Our intention is to return to our previously planned scope of work and deliverables by then end of 2021. This includes restoration of planned budgetary needs to support on-going work and increase overall deliverables in the form of access to broadband IT and the ISWM Program mobile GIS solutions for inspections, asset management and record keeping required by the NYSDEC SPDES Small MS4 Permit. All current technical assistance, material support, training and education programming will continue as it has since 2004.

AUTHORIZING THE CHAIR TO ENTER INTO A RENEWAL AGREEMENT WITH CORNELL COOPERATIVE EXTENSION ASSOCIATION TO MANAGE THE MS4 STORMWATER MANAGEMENT PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the Environmental Conservation Law and the Regulations of the Department of Environmental Conservation impose requirements on Saratoga County and its cities, towns and villages for the management of stormwater; and

WHEREAS, it is beneficial for the County to maintain an MS4 Stormwater Management Program to assist the municipalities in complying with the regulations regarding stormwater management; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution 124-2018, this Board authorized an agreement with Cornell Cooperative Extension of Saratoga County to administer the County's MS4 Stormwater Management Program for a term of three (3) years from 2018-2020 at a cost not to exceed \$183,200 for 2018, \$185,948 for 2019 and \$188,737 for 2020; and

Whereas, pursuant to resolution 48-2021 this Board authorized a one year extension to the agreement authorized by Resolution 124-2018; and

WHEREAS, our Economic Development Committee has recommended that the current agreement with Cornell Cooperative Extension Association of Saratoga County for the administration of the County's MS4 Stormwater Management Program be renewed for a term of one (1) 3 years commencing January 1, 2021-2 until December 31, 2024 at a cost not to exceed \$194,441.58 for 2022, \$197,358.20 for 2023, and \$200,318.57 for 2024; of \$188,737; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Chair of the Board is hereby authorized to execute an renewal agreement with Cornell Cooperative Extension Association of Saratoga County, for its services in administering the MS4 Stormwater Management Program for a term of one (1) three (3) years commencing January 1, 202+2, extending until December 31, 2024, at a cost not to exceed \$194,441.58 for 2022, \$197,358.20 for 2023, and \$200,318.57 for 2024; at a cost of \$188,737 with the form and content of such renewal agreement being subject to the approval of the County Attorney.
