Sheriff Zurlo couldn't be here with us today but he wanted me to express our welcome to all the new members of the board and members of the committee, we look forward to working with you this year. First resolution we have is for a lease agreement with Bancorp for three vehicles that we purchased. These went through the normal purchasing process and the purchasing department, however, it was determined afterwards that it would require a board resolution to actually sign the lease agreement.

This software is our records management as well as our security system. This is an annual housekeeping just a renewal of the contract with a small increase over last year. Costs this year to be \$45,842.

The next resolution is authorizing the Chairman of the Sheriff to enter into a contract with the Town of Halfmoon for specialized law enforcement services. This is a program we've had going for many, many years now with the Town of Halfmoon. There is a slight increase this year in accordance with the PBA contract of 2% for a total of \$230,863.29.

# **Steve Bayle**

Good. Good afternoon, Mr. Chairman, members of the committee. We're seeking a resolution to accept the ignition interlock device monitoring grant in an amount of \$22,088. The timeframe of this grant is from October 1 of last year to September 30. We only received notification in January that what the amount was for the grant. It's something that we've gotten for the past decade or more. And it reimburses us partially for the efforts to monitor the people who have ignition interlock devices ordered to be on their vehicles.

Oh, actually, that's an increase of \$55 from last year.

That's based, just a little extra information, it's based on the number of ignition interlock devices we have each year and we did remain about flat from 20 to 21. So.

# **Penny Heritage**

Oh, hanging in there. So thank you. Thank you, Mr. Chairman, and committee. The Animal Shelter proposes revising the structure of adoption fees and refunds. Instead of maintaining the same \$85 total for cats and dogs, which assumes a \$55 adoption fee, 15 \$15 vaccination fee and \$15 testing fee, we propose that adoptions going forward reflect the individual services provided, including \$20 for microchipping, which would be a new service and 2022. So to itemize that we propose no change to the \$55 adoption fee, charging a \$15 vaccination fee and \$15 testing fee only if it's administered by the animal shelter. Some of the animals come into us that have already been vaccinated and testing is not necessary for all animals. We propose adding the \$20 microchipping fee which is a great value and keeps adoptions affordable. And the \$6 New York State dog license fee still applies. Regarding refunds, we propose that the return to the shelter within 60 days receive a full refund of amounts paid, which includes adoption, vaccination testing and microchipping fee but excludes New York state dog licensing fee.
