#### **RESOLUTION 62 - 2017**

Introduced by Supervisors Lent, Allen, DeLucia, Lawler, Pemrick, Tollisen and Szczepaniak

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AUTHORIZING THE CHAIR TO EXECUTE A TOWER LICENSE AGREEMENT WITH THE CAPITAL DISTRICT TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY FOR THE PLACEMENT OF COMMUNICATIONS EQUIPMENT ON THE COUNTY'S RADIO COMMUNICATIONS TOWER ON MT. MCGREGOR IN THE TOWN OF MOREAU

WHEREAS, as part of the County's Emergency Radio System, the County constructed a radio communications tower on the site of the former Mt. McGregor State Correctional Facility located on Tax Parcel #88.-1-8 in the Town of Moreau; and

WHEREAS, the Capital District Transportation Authority ("CDTA") is interested in licensing space on the County's Mt. McGregor Radio Communications Tower for the placement, operation and maintenance of communications equipment in support of the operation of the CDTA's communications network; and

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WHEREAS, our Public Safety Committee and the Director of the County's Office of Emergency-Services have recommended that the County enter into a license agreement with the CDTA for the placement of communications equipment on the County's Mt. McGregor Radio Communications Tower for a term of five (5) years commencing April 1, 2017, subject to renewal for an additional term of five (5) years, at a cost to the CDTA of \$20,500 per year during the initial five (5) year term and at a cost of \$22,550 per year during the renewal term; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Chair of the Board is hereby authorized to execute a Tower License Agreement with the Capital District Transportation Authority of Albany, New York, granting a license to the CDTA authorizing the placement, operation and maintenance of communications equipment of the County's Mt. McGregor Radio Communication Tower in the Town of Moreau, for a term of five (5) years commencing April 1, 2017; subject to renewal for an additional term of five (5) years upon the written mutual agreement of the parties, at a cost to the CDTA of \$20,500 per year for the initial five (5) year term, and at a cost of \$22,550 per year during the renewal term; and, be it further

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RESOLVED, that the form and content of such Tower License Agreement shall be subject to the approval of the County Attorney.

#### TOWER LICENSE AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT (the "Agreement") is entered into this  $27^{+}$  day of April 2, 2017 (the "Effective Date")

By and Between

COUNTY OF SARATOGA, a municipal corporation duly organized and existing under the laws of the State of New York, with a principal office at 40 McMaster Street, Ballston Spa, New York 12020 (the "County")

and

CAPITAL DISTRICT TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY, a public authority duly organized under the laws of the State of New York, with its principal place of business at 110 Watervliet Ave., Albany, NY 12206 (the "Licensee")

#### WITNESSETH:

In consideration of mutual covenants contained herein and intending to be legally bound hereby, the parties agree as follows:

#### 1.DEFINITIONS

- 1.1 Basic Payment means the consideration payable by the Licensee to the County of Saratoga in exchange for the use of the Mt. McGregor Tower facility in the amount of 20,500.00 (Twenty Thousand Five Hundred Dollars) per year to be paid in equal monthly installments of \$1,708.33.
- 1.2 Communications Facility Means communications shelter, tower and CDTA proposals to be used at the Mt. McGregor facility on Mt. McGregor Road as set forth in the map and plans titled "Capital District Transportation Authority 800Mhz Project 25 Public Safety Communications System" attached hereto as Exhibit A.
- 1.3 Commencement Date Means the first day of the month following the signing of this agreement by all parties.
- 1.4 Equipment Means authorized Motorola 800 MHz Project 25 Communications Equipment to be used at the Mt. McGregor facility as identified in Collocation Application attached hereto as Exhibit B.
- 1.5 Initial Term means a period of (five (5) years) following the Commencement Date.
- 1.6 <u>Site</u> The site consists of that certain parcel of property located in the Town of Moreau, the County of Saratoga, and the State New York, and further identified as Tax Map Parcel No. 88.1-8 which is shown on Exhibit C, attached hereto and made a part hereof.

#### 2. LICENSE TO INSTALL, OPERATE AND MAINTAIN EQUIPMENT

2.1 <u>License to Install, Operate and Maintain Equipment</u> - The County hereby grants a license to the Licensee to install, operate and maintain authorized equipment at the site within the licensed space; as such equipment and licensed space are described in, and subject to, the approved "Collocation Application" attached hereto as Exhibit B and as shown in the four page site plan collectively

labeled as Exhibit A (the "Communications Facility"). Such license is subject to the site rules as promulgated by the County and communicated to Licensee, and is restricted exclusively to the installation, operation and maintenance of antennas and equipment consistent with the specifications and in the locations identified in Exhibit A.

- 2.2 Application for Modification Licensee shall apply to make modifications by submitting a request to the County in writing with technical documentation outlining the modifications, and such other information as may be required by the County to sufficiently analyze the request for modification to the site. The Licensee shall be responsible for reasonable costs the County may incur for engineering analysis of the Licensee's application. The County shall advise the Licensee of those costs prior to the submission of the application for modification. The County may require a structural analysis be conducted by an engineering firm of the County's choice. An intermodulation study may be required by the County in connection with the proposed modification, and the reasonable cost for the review of the intermodulation study by a consultant of the County's choice to be paid by the Licensee. No modification may be undertaken by the Licensee until such time as written permission has been granted by the County. Such written permission shall constitute an amendment to this Agreement. Notwithstanding the foregoing, Licensee maintains the right to perform routine maintenance and repairs, without County's written permission when no changes to the exterior appearance of the Communications Facility are made. Licensee shall obtain the county's prior written permission for all replacements and upgrades proposed to be made to the Communications Facility.
- 2.3 Conditions Precedent to Installation of Equipment or Commencement of Term or Modification Notwithstanding anything to the contrary herein, the parties agree that the term of this Agreement shall not become effective, and Licensee's right to install equipment, or make modifications to equipment at the site shall not commence until the following conditions are satisfied:
  - a. The Site Application has been approved by the County; and
  - b. A structural analysis has been conducted and approved by the County; and
  - c. Anintermodulation RF study has been conducted and approved by the County; and
  - d. The Licensee has supplied all required permits to the County from all required Governmental authorities allowing installation; and
  - e. All fees have been paid to the County and others as required; and
  - f. Written authorization from the County has been supplied to the Licensee for the installation of equipment; and
  - g. Any other requirements imposed by the County are satisfied.

In the event that Licensee breaches this Agreement by installing equipment or making modifications other than as permitted hereunder, then in addition to all other remedies available to the County, the County shall be entitled to receive and the Licensee shall pay to the County, upon notice from the County, an administrative fee equal to one-half the basic fee in an annual amount.

- 2.4 <u>Performance of Work</u> The Licensee shall notify the County when work of any kind is to be performed at the site (inclusive of tower, shelter and other peripheral equipment) 48 hours in advance. If the work to be performed is emergency work the County shall be notified immediately. Notice may be provided by telephone using the telephone numbers in Section 3.3. The County shall be sole judge of the workmanship compliance at the site. If required by the County, the Licensee agrees to remedy any deficiencies in workmanship to the site upon notification by the County.
- 2.5 <u>Documentation</u> The Licensee shall provide to the County the following documentation prior

to installing any equipment at the site:

- Structural Analysis
- Building Permit
- Intermodulation Studies
- Site Plans
- Antennae Specifications
- ERP of RF output
- FCC Licenses
- Insurance Certificates
- Any other documents reasonably requested by the County

Such documents shall be made available to the County within ten (10) days of its request. Failure to provide documents shall constitute a breach of this Agreement.

#### 3. ACCESS TO AND USE OF SITE

- 3.1 Access to Site The County hereby grants to the Licensee a non-exclusive license for pedestrian and vehicular ingress and egress from the site over the designated access route to the site as depicted in Exhibit C on a 24 hour, seven (7) days per week basis, subject to proper notifications as described in Section 2.4 for the sole purpose of maintaining, operating and repairing the Communications Facility, together with the license to maintain, operate and repair utility lines, wires, cables and other means of providing utility service to the site. The County shall have no duty to remove snow from the access road.
- 3.2 <u>Authorized Persons</u>; <u>Safety of Personnel</u> Licensee's right to access shall be limited to authorized employees, contractors and sub-contractors of the Licensee or other persons under their direct supervision. Licensee shall not allow any person to climb the tower without ensuring that such person works for a vendor approved by the County for the subject work.
- 3.3 Notice to County The Licensee agrees to provide the County prior notice of any access to the site by the Licensee as described in Section 2.4. The Licensee shall notify the Saratoga County Office of Emergency Services at 518-885-2232 or after hours 518-885-6761 (Sheriff's Department).
- 3.4 <u>Licensee's Use of Site</u> The Licensee shall use the site to install, operate and maintain the equipment approved for the site as described in Exhibit B. The Licensee shall transmit and receive only within the frequency ranges approved by the County and identified by Licensee in Exhibit B; provided, however, that identification of frequencies is for the limited purpose of coordinating frequencies to prevent interference and does not establish any limits on Licensee's ability to use any and all frequencies available to Licensee or its rights in this Agreement. Notwithstanding the foregoing, if Licensee needs to modify its approved equipment to accommodate use of a frequency band, Licensee shall first obtain the County's written permission prior to making any such modification consistent with Section 2.2.
- 3.5 <u>Permits, Authorizations and Licenses</u> The Licensee shall be solely responsible for obtaining, at its own expense, all permits, authorizations (local zoning, local planning) and licenses associated with it occupancy of the licensed space.

3.6 <u>Utilities</u> - Licensee shall pay for all electricity and other utilities it uses. Separate metering is required.

#### 4. TERMS

- 4.1 <u>Term of Agreement</u> The initial license term will be five (5) years ("Initial Term"), commencing on the Effective Date. The Initial Term will terminate on the fifth (5) anniversary of the Effective Date.
- 4.2 <u>Term Renewal</u> This Agreement will automatically renew for four (4) additional five (5) year terms (each five (5) year term shall be defined as an ("Extension Term"), upon the same terms and conditions unless the Licensee notifies the County in writing of Licensee's intention not to renew this Agreement at least sixty (60) days prior to the expiration of the Initial Term or Extension Term, as applicable.

#### 5. CONSIDERATION

- 5.1. <u>Basic Payment</u> Commencing in the month following the date that Licensee commences construction (the "Rent Commencement Date"), Licensee shall pay to the County of Saratoga \$20,500 per year for its license and use of the site, access road and easements to the site. The County's payment shall be remitted to the County of Saratoga, 40 McMaster Street. Ballston Spa, NY 12020. The Licenses shall include the MCGREGOR Tower Payment on each payment. Payments shall be made in equal monthly installments (\$1,708.33) per month during the ("Initial Term") on or before the fifth (5th) day of the month.
- 5.2 <u>Adjustments to Basic Payment</u> The basic payment shall be increased upon the renewal of the Agreement for an Extension Term of five (5) years with an increase of 10% percent (\$22,550 per year). The payment shall never decrease.
- 5.3 <u>Taxes</u> The Licensee shall be responsible to pay any real property taxes attributed to the installation of its Communication Facility at the site. The Licensee shall hold the County and land owner, harmless from any tax payments owed by Licensee under this Section 5.3.

#### **6. INTERFERENCE**

6.1 Interference by Licensee - The Licensee agrees it shall not operate its Communication Facility at the site in such a fashion as to cause RF interference with the County's Public Safety Radio Equipment. If the Licensee is notified that its Communications Facility is causing interference, the Licensee shall immediately discontinue transmitting and receiving at the site and take immediate action to correct the interference problem. The County may grant, after the Effective Date, a lease, license or any other right to any third party for use of the property identified in Section 2.1, provided such use does not interfere with the Communications Facility, the operations of Licensee or the rights of Licensee under this Agreement. The County will neither interfere with Licensee's Communications Facility, the operation of Licensee or the rights of Licensee under this Agreement, nor will the County permit its employees, tenants, licensees, invitees, agents or contractors to do so. County will take reasonable precautions to prevent interference with Licensee's operations. The County anticipates entering into additional licensing agreements for this tower site with third party carriers, and agrees that it will insert language into such additional licensing agreements which will prohibit such third party carriers from interfering with Licensee's Communications Facility or its rights under this Agreement.

#### 7. INSURANCE

7.1 <u>Insurance</u> -The Licensee shall at all times maintain liability insurance covering the site in terms and form as is satisfactory to the County. The County acknowledges that Licensee is self-insured, and that Licensee's current level of self-insured retention is \$2,000,000 per occurrence with excess insurance available from New Hampshire Insurance Company to a combined level of \$13,000,000. Licensee shall provide the County with written notice of any change in the Licensee's self-insured status and/or the foregoing limits within 30 days of each such change by mailing such written notice to County's address set forth in Section 12.1 herein.

#### **8. MUTUAL INDEMNIFICATION**

8.1 Each party shall indemnify, defend and hold the other party, its affiliates, subsidiaries, directors, officers, employees and contractors harmless from and against any claim, action, damages, liability, loss, cost or expense (including reasonable attorney's fees), resulting from or arising out of indemnifying party's and/or any of its subcontractors, servants, agents or invitees' use of or occupancy of the Site. This clause shall not be construed to limit, or otherwise impair, any other rights or obligations of indemnity which exist in law, or in equity, for the benefit of either party.

#### 9. DEFAULTS, REMEDIES, WAIVER OF CONSEQUENTIAL DAMAGES

9.1 Failure by the Licensee to either pay any amount due hereunder within thirty (30) days of written notice from the County that said payment is delinquent or cure any breach of any covenant (not related to timeliness of payments) herein with thirty (30) days of written notice from the County of said breach shall constitute an event of default hereunder. Failure by the County to cure any breach of any covenant herein within thirty (30) days of written notice from the Licensee shall constitute an event of default hereunder. In the event of default, Licensee shall immediately make full payment of all amounts that are payable pursuant to Section 5.1 of this Agreement for such Initial Term or Extension Term, as applicable. Except as otherwise provided in the Agreement, neither party shall be liable to the other for consequential, indirect, special, punitive or exemplary damages for any cause of action whether in contract, tort or otherwise.

#### 10. GOVERNING LAW AND VENUE

10.1 The laws of the State of New York shall govern this Agreement and any litigation related to this Agreement shall be venued in a court of competent jurisdiction located in the County of Saratoga, State of New York.

#### 11.ASSIGNMENT, SUBLEASE, SHARING

11.1 The Agreement may not be sold, assigned or transferred in whole or in part by the Licensee without prior written permission from the County. However, Licensee will have the right to assign, sell or transfer its interest under this Agreement without prior written permission from the County to Licensee's "affiliate" (hereinafter defined) or to any entity which acquires all or substantially all of the Licensee's assets in the market defined by the FCC in which the site is located by reason of a merger, acquisition, or other business reorganization. An affiliate is any person or entity that directly or indirectly controls, is controlled by, or is under common control with, the Licensee, where control shall mean the power to direct the management of the policies of that person or entity, whether through the ownership of voting securities, contract, agency, or

otherwise. The Licensee shall not sub-lease its interest in this Agreement without prior written permission from the County. The Licensee shall not share the use of its equipment with any non-affiliate third party.

#### 12. NOTICES

12.1 All notices hereunder shall be in writing and shall be given by established express delivery service which maintains records, hand delivery or certified registered mail, postage prepaid, return receipt requested. Notices may also be given by facsimile transmission, provided the notice is concurrently given by one of the above methods. Notices are effective upon receipt, or upon attempted delivery if delivery is refused or if delivery is impossible. Notices shall be sent to the parties at the following addresses:

#### 13. TERMINATION

- 13.1 <u>Termination of Agreement</u>- This Agreement may be terminated, without penalty or further liability, as follows:
  - a. by either party if the other party is in default as described in Section 9.1 or elsewhere in this Agreement after the applicable cure periods; or
  - b. by Licensee upon written notice to the County if Licensee is unable to obtain, or maintain, any required approvals or the issuance of a license or permit by any agency, board, court or other governmental authority necessary for the construction or operation of the Communication Facility; or
  - c. by Licensee, upon written notice to the County for any reason or no reason, at any time prior to commencement of construction by Licensee; or
  - d. by Licensee upon 60 days prior written notice to the County for any reason or no reason, so long as Licensee pays the County a termination fee equal to 1/4 of the annual basic payment under Section 5.1; or

- e. by the County, upon 90 days prior written notice to the Licensee, in the event the County's APA permit for the tower is revoked, cancelled, or terminated for any reason.
- 13.2 <u>Removal of Communications Facility</u> Within 90 days of the expiration or earlier termination of this Agreement, Licensee will remove the Communications Facility from the site and, to the extent reasonable, will restore the site to its condition at the commencement of this Agreement, reasonable wear and tear and loss by other causes beyond Tenant's control excepted.

#### 14. LIABILITY FOR MARKING AND LIGHTING TOWER

14.1 The County shall light the tower, at its expense, if the tower is required by the FAA and or/ FCC to be lit.

WHEREAS, the Albany County Sheriff's Office, the Saratoga County Sheriff's CFC 1/5 Office and the Saratoga County Office of Emergency Services wish to construct a shared interoperable 9-1-1 Telephone, Computer Aid Dispatch and Records Management Network to serve Albany and Saratoga Counties; using existing infrastructure in both Counties, and replacing, upgrading, and purchasing new infrastructure through a 1/4 the Counties combination of grant funds and E911 surcharge funds; and

WHEREAS, the shared interoperable 9-1-1 telephone, CAD, and records management network will serve all first responders in Albany and Saratoga Counties, as well as being capable of interfacing with other public service agencies and surrounding counties; and

WHEREAS, current plans call for Albany and Saratoga Counties to solicit the participation of other surrounding counties and municipalities to form a larger shared network by expanding the system and distributing the costs with other participating members; and

WHEREAS, Albany and Saratoga County recognize the fieed to form a regulatory Board of Directors for purposes of implementing, managing and creating policy to govern the interoperable communications system; and

WHEREAS, the Albany County Sheriff's Department, Saratoga County Sheriff's Department and Saratoga County Office of Emergency Services have proposed that Albany County and Saratoga County enter into an intermunicipal agreement setting forth the financial, operational, and maintenance responsibilities of the two counties in the establishment of the shared interoperable 9-1-1 telephone, CAD and records management

network, and establishing a regulatory Board of Directors to govern the interoperable communications system; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Chair of the Board is authorized to execute an intermunicipal agreement with the County of Albany establishing a shared interoperable 9-1-1 Telephone, Computer Aided Dispatch, and Records Management Network to serve Albany and Saratoga Counties, as well as any other surrounding counties and municipalities wishing to join the interoperable communications network, and establishing a regulatory Board of Directors to govern the network, with said intermunicipal agreement to be for a term of ten (10) years commencing January 1, 2016 and terminating on December 31, 2025; and, be it further

RESOLVED, that the form and content of such intermunicipal agreement shall be subject to the approval of the County Attorney.

**RESOLVED**, that the Chair of the Board is authorized to execute an agreement with Pittsfield Communications Systems, Inc. of Pittsfield, Massachusetts, for the maintenance of the County's public safety radio system equipment maintained by the Office of Emergency Services, the Department of Public Works, the District Attorney's Office, and the Sheriff's Department, for a term of three years commencing September 1, 2021 and terminating August 31, 2024, subject to renewal for a term of one year, at an annual cost not to exceed \$35,000; and be it further



The 2022 program continues to provide financial support to the Alcohol & Substance Abuse Council of Saratoga County. This consists of the following programs and activities:
Safe Spring Campaign:
Safe Spring- a comprehensive countywide campaign against youthful DWI. This program operates year round and includes the following:
SADD chapters in 13 high schools which share a monthly coordinating council meeting to plan countywide initiatives, share ideas and successes and gain information and support for their chapter activities. There are town and countywide activities each years developed by program participants. In addition, the Prevention Council provides assistance, program coordination and advisors meetings to help build local chapters.
Safe Spring Student Leadership Conference. This annual event brings together nearly 300 youth and 50 adults for the purpose of preventing DWI and other tragedies during the high risk spring season. It builds in students the motivation and leadership skills to design and lead local programs. Youth participate in workshops on topics of vital concern such as teen relationships, conflict resolution, problem solving, binge drinking, depression, etc. They also develop skills in public presentation, group building facilitation and advocacy. Following the conference, teams return to their schools to plan victim impact panels, after prom activities, assemblies, mock crashes, "dead days" and other educational events for their schools and comunities.
The Prevetion Council also prints and distributes a "Prom Night" brochure to the parents of 11th & 12th grade students. The brochure provides facts and suggestions about safe and alcohol-free prom preparation and celebrations. Over 5,000 brochures are handed out to and shared with parents in nearly all districts across Saratoga County. Distribution is also through shops selling or renting dresses/tuxes in Saratoga County.
DWI Victim Impact Panels. Saratoga County stages 10-12 Victim Impact Panels annually. Funding in support of our VIPs will help offset costs of updating panel curriculum.
After Prom Activities. STOP DWI will continue to offer grants to each high school within Saratoga County to assist in the organization and sponsorship of chemical free parties following Junior and Senior Proms. The grants enable activities that carry school & community endorsement and provide a safe and positive alternative for high school students.
