Saratoga County Public Health to Hold Walk-in Vaccine Clinic

All COVID Vaccine Doses; First & Second Dose Boosters Available

BALLSTON SPA, NY –Saratoga County is holding a walk-in COVID-19 vaccination clinic Thursday, April 14, 2022 from 1:30PM to 3:30PM at Saratoga County Public Health at 6012 County Farm Road, Ballston Spa. First dose, second dose, third dose and first and second dose boosters for Moderna, Pfizer, and J&J will be available.

The vaccines are free. No proof of insurance required.

First Dose Booster Eligibility: The Pfizer booster is for those individuals 12 years of age and older. The Moderna booster is for ages 18 and older. To be eligible for a booster, persons must have received their second dose of Pfizer or Moderna vaccine at least 5 months ago or their Johnson and Johnson vaccine at least 2 months ago.

Second Dose Booster Eligibility:

- People age 12 and older who are moderately or severely immunocompromised may choose to receive a second booster dose using Moderna or Pfizer at least 4 months after the first booster dose.
- All adults ages 50 years and older regardless of health status may choose to receive a second booster dose using Moderna or Pfizer at least 4 months after the first booster dose.
- People ages 18–49 years regardless of health status who received Janssen/Johnson & Johnson's (J&J) COVID-19 vaccine as both their primary series dose and booster dose may receive a second booster dose using Pfizer or Moderna vaccine at least 4 months after the first Janssen booster

Pfizer COVID-19 vaccination clinics include K12 students who reside in Saratoga County or attend a school located in Saratoga County. The child to be vaccinated should be accompanied by their parent or guardian. If the child is unaccompanied by their parent or guardian (for example, accompanied by a grandparent), a written consent form signed by the parent or guardian must be available at the time of the minor's vaccination.
