AUTHORIZING APPLICATION FOR AND ACCEPTANCE OF FEDERAL FUNDS FOR THE WORKFORCE INNOVATION AND OPPORTUNITY ACT PROGRAM FOR THE 2021-2022 PROGRAM YEAR, AND AMENDING THE BUDGET IN RELATION THERETO

2,036,861

WHEREAS, Saratoga County is the designated grant recipient for \$1,874,612 in grant funds provided through the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act of 2014 (WIOA) to be awarded to Saratoga, Warren and Washington Counties for the program year 2021-2022; and

WHEREAS, Saratoga County's available share of said federal funds for its Workforce Development Area Program is \$765,508.87, an increase of \$41,897 from the County's share in the 2020-2021 program year; and \$33,462.13 72,953.04

WHEREAS, this funding will allow Saratoga County to providing employment and training services for Adults, Youth and Dislocated Workers throughout the region and our county; and

WHEREAS, the authorization of this Board to execute documents for the application for and acceptance of these funds is needed, as well as an amendment to the 2021 County Budget; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Chair of the Board and/or the Director of Employment and Training is authorized to execute all documents necessary to apply for and accept Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act funds for the program year 2021-2022, with the form and substance of such documents being subject to the approval of the County Attorney; and, be it further
