Meeting called to order at 3:12pm by Chairman Ropitzky.

- 1. Minutes of June 2022 Meeting: Motion to approve by Bartow, seconded by Matthews, carried unanimously.
- 2. June 2022 Financial Reports:
 - a. Receipts/Disbursements Report, Budget vs Actual Report and Vouchers: (Attachment A, B & C)

 Motion to approve made by Matthews, seconded by Bartow, carried unanimously.
- 3. Field Report: (Attachment D)
- 4. Cooperating Agency Reports:
 - a. **NRCS:** Girard reported that NRCS will have an OSHA inspection on 07/21/22, they are looking for chemicals, that the hallways are clear, etc. Had 1 high tunnel contract obligation in Rexford, 2 more moving forward; paid out 1 high tunnel in Gansevoort, received 2 more applications. Soil health assessments were completed, 1 site visit for a covered barnyard. A professor at Skidmore is working on carbon mapping on Farms, this is part of a nationwide project. He is looking for more farms in Hudson Valley are and is offering test kits for farms to do on their own, cost is on a case-by-case basis.
 - b. **FSA:** No report.
 - c. RC&D: Lewis reported that a meeting was held for purposes of giving RC&D President the ability of working with an attorney to start the closeout process. Any leftover funds with be given to UHWC. UHWC will hold those funds for any additional RC&D expenses after the closeout.
 - d. **NYSSWCC:** Monthly report was distributed by email. State Committee meeting is next Tuesday, Lewis expects the CRF rankings will be given at that meeting.
 - e. **NYACD:** Annual meeting coming up in October.
 - f. **CCE:** The Fair is this week. The District has a booth with multiple displays.

5. Old Business:

- a. Water Quality Coordinating Committee: Draft minutes were distributed to all.
- b. Grants: Lewis reported on the following:
 - i. Agricultural Environmental Management Projects are moving along, Palemire has spoken with an engineer on Tier 4 projects and will be doing AEM farm visits for both Saratoga & Warren SWCDs.
 - ii. Septic Multiple calls have been received for information on the grant but no callers reside in the eligible area.
 - iii. Roadside Erosion -
 - 1. Approval of payments when funds are rec'd: A **motion** was made to issue payment of \$13,086.00 to Essex SWCD and \$15,379.20 to Washington SWCD pending funds from NYS, Matthews made a motion, seconded by Garlanda, carried unanimously.
 - iv. Resiliency Training This grant ends in October. Franklin County recently held a training, a training is being planned in Fulton County & Saratoga County is required to hold one more training. The last training will probably be held in October, it will be geared towards Highway Depts & local municipalities.
 - v. Micro Irrigation Grant Have not gotten confirmation on if all the parts have been received.
 - vi. Records Retention Grant McCarthy is working on the closeout of the grant and advised that the District was not awarded a grant for the 2022 2023 round.
- **c.** <u>Saratoga County Lease:</u> The County has provided an approved Lease for signature. The rental rate is \$1.00 per year, the term is 30 years with an option for renewal. The lease begins 09/01/22 and ends 08/31/52. A **motion** to enter into a lease with Saratoga County and start the bid process for the building was made by Garlanda, seconded by Matthews, carried unanimously.
- **d. 2023 Budget** (Attachment E): Discussion was held on 2 proposed budgets with different pay increases for the staff. A decision was made to table further discussion until the next meeting in hopes of having

more Directors available for discussion. The Board requested that Lewis email Directors to request feedback on both budgets in case someone cannot make the next meeting.

6. New Business:

- a. <u>WQIP Applications:</u> Lewis advised the staff would like to submit 2 applications for WQIP. 1 grant would be funding for hydroseeding materials. The other application would be on behalf of Galway Highway Department for a new salt shed. The current shed is small, falling and is inadequate for their needs. The Highway Department reached out to the District for assistance in applying for a grant. A motion to submit 2 applications for the WQIP Program as described was made by Bartow, seconded by Matthews, carried unanimously.
- 7. Executive Session (if needed): A motion to enter into Executive Session for the purpose of discussing the health/medical of a current employee was made at 4:30pm by Bartow, second by Matthews, carried unanimously. A motion was made to come out of Executive Session was made at 4:49pm by Matthews, second by Bartow, carried unanimously.
