Authorize a contract with James H. Maloy, Inc., low bidder, in the amount of \$167,000 for repairs to the County Route 7 bridge over Daly Creek in the Town of Day. The bridge was issued a yellow flag in 2021 for undermining of the culvert wall. Public Works budgeted \$130,000 for this repair based on a preliminary estimate completed in 2021. Maloy was the low bid at \$167,000 which would require a budget amendment in the amount of \$37,000.

The subject project was let for construction on August 04, 2022 with three (3) bids received and opened at the office of the Saratoga County Purchasing Department, Saratoga County Office Building, 50 W. High Street, Ballston Spa, NY 12020 at 11:00am. The engineer's estimate for the bid of the project was \$93,580.00 and the following three (3) bids were analyzed:

The bid was reviewed and checked, and all computations were verified by Luke Short, PE, Project Engineer, Creighton Manning Engineering, LLP on August 05, 2022.

The low bid of \$167,000.00 as submitted by James H. Maloy, Inc. was reviewed and found to be complete and accurate regarding bid documentation, consistent bid pricing, and company experience with similar projects. The overall bid was 78% higher than the engineer's estimate with four individual items found to be 25 percent or more above the engineer's estimate. The four items are all associated with working within the stream. The higher bid pricing may be a factor of the accelerated schedule to meet in-stream work deadlines and risk of high water storm events. Additionally, the higher bid prices are consistent with bids that we have seen recently within the current economic climate.

Based upon the foregoing bid results, I, acting on behalf of Creighton Manning Engineering, LLP, recommend the Saratoga County Department of Public Works:

Bridge and Culvert Rehabilitation Projects

Dimmick Road Bridge over Snook Kill, BIN 3304510, Town of Wilton – Originally included in our 2022 Capital Plan, this project was put on hold earlier in the year pending funding on the 22-27 CDTC TIP. We are awaiting the final approved TIP to begin the project engineering in the year that it will be funded.

Corinth Bridge Rail Replacement, BIN 3305510, Town of Corinth – Locally funded. COMPLETED.

Hans Creek Bridge Road Bridge over Hans Creek, BIN 2202830, Town of Providence – Locally Funded. Engineering is in progress. Construction is planned for 2023.

CR 4 (North Shore Road) over Beecher Creek, BIN 3304790, Town of Edinburg – Locally funded. Engineering is in progress. Construction is planned for 2023.

CR 49 (West Milton Road), BIN 3304560, Town of Milton – This project is being locally funded with ARRPA Funds. Engineering is in progress. Construction is planned for 2023.

CR 1 (Stony Creek Road) over Wolf Creek Flag Repair, BIN 3304230, Town of Hadley – Locally funded. The contractor is awaiting steel delivery. Repairs are scheduled to be completed this construction season.
