The existing box culvert has experienced some deterioration which lowered its rating to a point that supports full replacement. The new structure will be a precast concrete structure with precast wingwalls and headwalls. The total project cost including professional services and construction is anticipated to total approximately \$1,197,000.

RESOLVED, that in the event the full federal and non-federal share costs of the project exceeds the amount appropriated above, <u>Saratoga County Board of Supervisors</u> shall convene as soon as possible to appropriate said excess amount immediately upon the notification by the New York State Department of Transportation thereof, and it is further

RESOLVED, that the Chairman of the Board of Supervisors be and is hereby authorized to execute all necessary Agreements, certifications or reimbursement requests for Federal Aid and/or Marchiselli Aid on behalf of the County of Saratoga with the New York State Department of Transportation in connection with the advancement or approval of the Project and providing for the administration of the Project and the municipality's first instance funding of project costs and permanent funding of the local share of federal-aid and state-aid eligible Project costs and all Project costs within appropriations therefore that are not so eligible, and it is further

RESOLVED, that a certified copy of this resolution be filed with the New York State Commissioner of Transportation by attaching it to any necessary Agreement in connection with the Project and it is further

AUTHORIZING THE CHAIRMAN TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH BARTON AND LOGUIDICE, D.P.C. FOR PRELIMINARY AND DETAILED DESIGN SERVICES RELATED TO THE REPLACEMENT OF THE CR 24 (SPIER FALLS ROAD) CULVERT OVER A HUDSON RIVER TRIBUTARY IN THE TOWN OF MOREAU

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution _____-2022, this Board of Supervisors approved the proposed project for the replacement of the CR 24 (Spier Falls Road) culvert over a Hudon River Tributary, LIN 251, PIN 1761.41 in the Town of Moreau; and

WHEREAS, the County is authorized to contract with any of the consultants designated by the New York State Department of Transportation (NYSDOT) to provide services for locally administered federal and/or state-aided municipal highway, bridge, and related projects that require architectural/engineering/surveying services in NYSDOT Region 1; and

WHEREAS, the Saratoga County Department of Public Works has evaluated and ranked all firms on NYSDOT's Region 1 Local Design Service Agreement List, and has selected Barton and Loguidice, D.P.C. to provide Preliminary and Detailed Design services related to the replacement of the CR 24 (Spier Falls Road) culvert over a Hudon River Tributary in the Town of Moreau; and

WHEREAS, our Public Works Committee and the Commissioner of the County Department of Public Works have recommended that a contract for preliminary and detailed design services related to the replacement of the CR 24 (Spier Falls Road) culvert over a Hudon River Tributary in the Town of Moreau be awarded to Barton and Loguidice, D.P.C. at a cost not to exceed \$147,559; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Chair of the Board is authorized to execute an agreement with Barton and Loguidice, D.P.C. of Albany, New York for the provision of preliminary and detailed design services for the proposed replacement of the CR 24 (Spier Falls Road) culvert over a Hudon River Tributary in the Town of Moreau, at a cost not to exceed \$147,559; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the form and content of such agreement shall be subject to the approval of the County Attorney; and, be it further

RESOLVED, that this Resolution shall take effect immediately.
