Great News!! You can now search census and naturalization records via computer both in the Saratoga County Clerk's Office and on-line (www.saratogacountyny.gov).

This records management project (which took over two years to complete) involved having the census and naturalization records scanned, creating an instructional manual and working with our vendor to enhance our existing computer software. With over 22,000 pages of Census and Naturalization records available, we believe making these records available digitally (both on-line and in-office) will be a huge convenience to our customers. It also has allowed us to store the paper originals safely in our fire proof vault. As we receive many requests for these records, we felt that these record series were important to preserve, protect and make digitally accessible to people interested in this information. The instructions for use may be downloaded in PDF form at/or perused via computer. There are two separate instruction packets for the census information; On-Line Infodex and In-Office Infodex. We hope that you find them easy to follow.


