10. Remarks:

As part of the final enacted FY 2023-2024 State budget, County Law Section 722-b was amended to increase the hourly rate paid to assigned counsel from \$60/hr for misdemeanors and \$75/hr for all other types of assigned counsel matters to \$158/hr for all types of matters under County Law Article 18-B. The rate increase became effective April 1, 2023. News of this amendment occurred after the 2023 County budget had already been adopted months prior and has now created a budget shortfall.

RESOLUTION 259 - 2021

AUTHORIZING A TRANSFER OF FUNDS TO THE HUMAN RESOURCES DEPARTMENT TO PAY FOR EXPENSES RELATED TO ARTICLE 18-B ATTORNEY SERVICES, AND AMENDING THE 2023 BUDGET IN RELATION THERETO

WHEREAS, pursuant to its authority under County Law Article 18-B, Saratoga County has established a mixed mandated representation system which combines the services of Public Defenders and Conflict Defenders and an assigned counsel panel of private attorneys to provide legal representation to eligible individuals in need of defense who are financially unable to obtain legal representation; and

WHEREAS, due to the impact COVID-19 had on the Court system in 2020, many cases could not proceed through the system to conclusion, creating a backlog of cases which are now being disposed of in 2021, causing an increase in assigned counsel attorney invoices; and County Law Section 722-b was amended to increase the hourly rate paid to assigned counsel from \$60 per hour for misdemeanors and \$75 per hour for all other types of assigned counsel matters to \$158 per hour for all types of matters under County Law Article 18-B effective April 1, 2023

WHEREAS, it is necessary to amend the 2023 Saratoga County Budget to effect a transfer of \$160,000 from Fund Balance to the Human Resources Department in order to pay for additional assigned counsel attorney services; now, therefore be it
