Saratoga County Economic Development Grants Updates/Reserve Fund Transfer

The Town of Day and the Village of Victory are seeking reimbursement for their Economic Development Grant projects. Committee approval is required for the municipalities to be reimbursed. The Village of Victory will require a Board resolution to transfer funds from the Economic Development Grant Reserve Fund (A.0888.ED) to the Municipal Planning Grant Program (A.80.000-8763). The Town of Day is a 2023 grant and will be paid out of the 2023 budget, so no transfer is necessary.

AUTHORIZING THE TRANSFER OF FUNDS FROM THE ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT GRANT RESERVE FUND AND AMENDING THE 2023 COUNTY BUDGET IN RELATION THERETO

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution 97-2021, this Board established a capital reserve fund to be known as the "Economic Dev Grant Reserve" for the purpose of depositing unexpended funds for the Municipal Economic Development Assistance Program; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution 97-2021 the reserve account was created to house the unexpended municipal economic grant program funds until such funds are needed, and a reimbursement voucher is submitted by the municipal applicant, at which point the funds will be appropriated to the General Fund budget; and

WHEREAS, the portion of unexpended grant funds from the 2022 Village of Victory total \$1,100.00; and

WHEREAS, the grant projects that were approved in 2022 have been submitted for payment and reimbursement were approved by our Economic Development Committee; and

WHEREAS, the transfer of Economic Development Grant Reserve funds to the Municipal Economic Development Assistance account requires this Board's approval and an associated amendment to the 2023 County budget; and

WHEREAS, our Economic Development Committee and the Director of Planning and Economic Development have recommended that \$1,100.00 be transferred from the Economic Development Grant Reserve funds to the Municipal Economic Development Assistance account; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that this Board authorizes the transfer of \$1,100.00 from the Economic Development Grant Reserve funds to the Municipal Economic Development Assistance account to provide reimbursement to municipal applicants as approved by our Economic Development Committee; and it is further

RESOLVED, that the Budget Officer is hereby authorized to enter the appropriate journal entries to reflect the approved budget transfer; and it is further

RESOLVED, that the 2023 Saratoga County Budget is amended as follows:

2023 Economic Development Grant Program

Background: The Saratoga County Board of Supervisors has allocated \$7,100 in grant funds per municipality to assist with economic development objectives. Grant funds are awarded directly to the municipality upon completion of the proposed project.

Eligible Applicants: All Saratoga County municipalities may apply for this grant program.

Eligible Costs: Grant funds may be used for costs associated with the planning, design, or construction of projects that further economic development within the municipality. The maximum amount of award for a single proposal is \$7,100.

Match Requirements: The grant program provides a reimbursement of the applicant's contribution to the project costs up to \$7,100.

Post Award: The funds must be spent by the municipality and then Saratoga County will issue a reimbursement when the request for funds is made. The Saratoga County Department of Planning and Economic Development is requesting the following documentation be provided when disbursal of the grant funding is sought by the municipality:

- 1. Reimbursement Request Form
- 2. Copies of invoices/receipts
- 3. Copies of cancelled checks

Once all the above-mentioned materials are provided, the request will be presented to the Economic Development Committee for reimbursement. Once the committee approves the reimbursement, a completed voucher will be sent to you for signature.

No grant monies shall be released without sufficient evidence of expenditures by the awardee.



09/28/2023 Discussion with Sheriff's Department regarding vandalism protection of community projects

Meeting Notes

Attendees (2):

Pete Bardunias, the Capital Region Chamber William Heid, Lieutenant, Saratoga County Sheriff's office

Discussion was called to see if there were any best practices available that might help local communities plan ahead and protect their projects from the impacts of vandals and other mischief.

Elements of Vandalism

Saratoga County Sheriff's Department tends to see the following types of vandalism:

- Carvings onto seats/structures (most common form of vandalism observed)
- Painting on surfaces
- Breaking things
- Arson

Ideas for Prevention

- Materials considerations
 - Metal versus wood
 - Stainless steel best to prevent carvings, etc
- Modular Construction
 - Build with panels that can be easily replaced versus a totally integrated construction that is hard to repair when a portion is damaged
- Cost considerations
 - o Build it really strong and solid (hard to damage, but costly)
 - o Build it really simple and flimsy (easily replaceable, cheap)
 - A combination of the two decide which pieces need to be robust versus what can be simple
 - Consider easily available parts (for example wood to repair damaged picnic tables)
 - Simplify materials costs where possible for example using same paint (by paint codes)
 at Historic Lock 19 and at the picnic area 2 miles away
 - Storage of parts/materials

- Plexiglas or other covering materials
 - Can cover sensitive signage or other materials so that the vandals damage the Plexiglas and not the item underneath (example the Exit 9 Rest Area Canal map)
- Make things visible!
 - Remove brush or other objects in front of the project in question so that it is more in the open, providing less cover for vandals to do damage without being seen



- Are cameras an option?
 - o Trail cameras can catch perpetrators and especially be useful in repeat situations
 - Put signs up saying there are cameras even if there are no cameras! Let the perp take the risk that it's a bluff
- Contact Sheriff's office
 - For recurring incidents, they can do an area check or target check, assign the incident a service number and inspect for about 2-3 weeks to see if they can spot evidence of someone returning to the scene
 - If a very specific time that the perpetrator is coming to the area, they can try to target that time and see if they can catch them in the act
- Be vigilant consider the overall picture

Maintenance Considerations

- Mayor Giuliani's "Broken Window" Rule
 - Fix things when they break
 - Apparent neglect leads to more vandalism
 - Nature can be as big a "vandal" too sometimes
- When considering a project, the following should be factored in:
 - O Who is going to do the ongoing maintenance?
 - Town/village departments?
 - Volunteers?
 - o What is the budget for replacement parts/spares?
 - "budget" can mean finding people willing to donate them
 - O Where will replacement parts be stored?

NOTE – GUIDANCE FOR STORE OWNERS

Store owners who wish to defend their premises need to be aware of Article 35 of NY State Penal Law, Part 1, Title C, which governs the use of force in defense of persons or property. Lt. Heid suggested the following:

- Call police if any theft is observed
- If a perpetrator is using a knife to cut boxes open, etc, do not approach them. The criminal has a knife, thus is armed and has an advantage. Call police instead and get the license plate if you can when the person departs
- CAMERAS ARE CHEAP!!! You can get facial recognition
- Armed store owners especially need to be aware of Article 35 and would have to articulate why
 there was an imminent threat to someone's safety will be a very serious concern should lethal
 force be used

Sometimes there is no substitute for just going out and fixing the problem – cant stop all incidents of vandalism and mischief







<u>Summary</u> – it appears that the Chamber's practices, done in conjunction with our members and their efficiency/safety teams, have been efficient and effective at minimizing and mitigating the effects of vandalism. Lt. Heid commented that the Sheriff's department isn't used to being consulted in advance but rather being called in reaction to malfeasance. He felt it was very refreshing to see our approach and hoped it would help others make considerations ahead of time to keep their public spaces safe and secure. He gave some good ideas for materials considerations and other concepts which could help in our work and these best practices should be shared across our communities. The Sheriff is the best option to keep people safe and prevent crimes, and contacting police to intervene in the event of theft or damage is the appropriate measure.
