Initial rent cost to AT&T Mobility will be \$30,000.00 and will be subject to a two percent (2%) yearly increase on the anniversary of the initial term.

CONSTRUCT A TEN-FOOT TOWER EXTENSION AND FOR THE PLACEMENT OF
COMMUNICATIONS EQUIPMENT ON THE COUNTY'S RADIO
COMMUNICATIONS TOWER IN THE TOWN OF PROVIDENCE MILTON

WHEREAS, as part of the County's Emergency Radio System, the County constructed a radio communications tower on County lands located at 7247 Barkersville Road 6010 County Farm Road in the Town of Providence-Milton, which lands are identified on the Saratoga County Tax Maps as Tax Parcel #147. 1-38.11 202.-2-5; and

WHEREAS, Celleo Partnership, d/b/a Verizon Wireless, ("Verizon Wireless") New Cingular Wireless PCS, LLC d/b/a AT&T Mobility ("AT&T Mobility") is interested in leasicensing space on the County's Communications to the Town of Providence Milton for the construction of a ten-foot tower extension and for the placement, operation and maintenance of communications equipment in support of the operation of Verizon Wireless's AT&T Mobility's communications network; and

WHEREAS, our Public Safety Committee and the Director of Emergency Management have recommended that the County enter into an amended a Tower License Structure Lease Agreement with Celleo Partnership, d/b/a Verizon Wireless

New Cingular Wireless PCS, LLC d/b/a AT&T Mobility for the construction of a ten-foot tower extension and for the placement of its communications equipment on the County's communications tower in the Town of Providence-Milton for an initial term of two (2) years commencing on August 1, 2023 the first day of the month following the date that AT&T Mobility commences construction, and will automatically renew for nine (9) additional terms of two (2) years each, at an initial rental cost to Verizon Wireless AT&T Mobility of \$30,000 per year during the initial two (2) years ever the preceding two (2) year term; on the anniversary of the Initial Term; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Chair of the Board is hereby authorized to execute an amended a Tower License Structure Lease Agreement with Celleo Partnership, d/b/a Verizon Wireless, of Bedminster, New Jersey, New Cingular Wireless PCS, LLC d/b/a AT&T Mobility, of Atlanta, Georgia AT&T Mobility granting a license lease to Celleo Partnership, d/b/a Verizon Wireless New Cingular Wireless PCS, LLC d/b/a AT&T Mobility; authorizing the construction of a tenfoot tower extension and for the placement, operation and maintenance of communications

equipment on the County's cenumunications the Town of Providence Milton, for an initial term of two (2) years commencing on August 1, 2023 the first day of the month following the date that AT&T Mobility commences construction, and that will automatically renew for nine (9) additional terms of two (2) years each, at an initial rental cost to Verizon Wireless AT&T Mobility of \$30,000 per year during the initial two (2) year term, subject to a two percent (2%) yearly increase on the anniversary of the Initial Term; for each renewal term of two (2) years over the preceding two (2) year term; and, be it further
